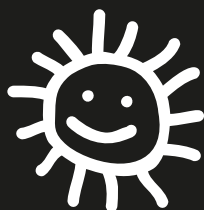

A sad farewell to Karmann, who has had the bull by the horns so often, thank you very much Karmann.

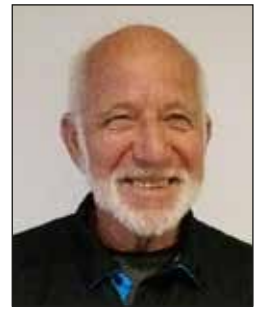

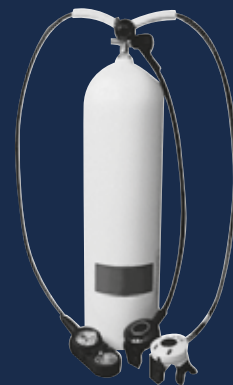

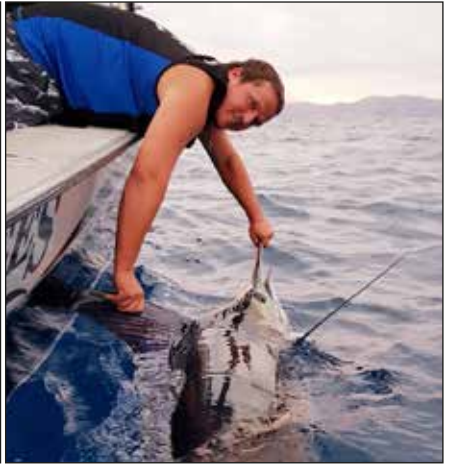

Hi, my name's Paige Haddock I'm 28 years old and have been a member of the Whakatane Sportfishing Club since I was two years old.

Over the years I have been lucky enough to grow up with fishing in my life and be a part of this awesome club.

My whole family have been involved in some form of fishing in Whakatane their whole lives whether that's the WSFC, coastguard, commercial fishing or just the love of being out on the water, so it was always going to be in my blood!

Some of my best memories growing up have been out on the water.

As soon as I could hold a fishing rod Dad would take me fishing, started off catching herrings on the wharf then trout fishing and of course out on the ocean.

Every year we would do the Trout Tournament on Lake Rotoiti, I still have great memories of all the members staying at the Rotoiti campground together, fishing, laughing and of course drinking! I might have been young, but I remember the big nights and late starts!

Pulling up to the weigh station and seeing the likes of Alby Meade and Kevin McCracken who both used to do very well when it came to trout fishing and thinking I would love to catch one that big one day!

Trout fishing has always been a passion trolling the lake with Dad all day waiting to run over one of these fish.

After Kevin McCracken had passed away, I was very fortunate to be given his trout gear by his wife Carolyn. Dad and I hit the lakes with his gear and left the last lure he had on his rod - a black toby (which Kevin used to always troll) didn't take long and we hooked up, landing a nice rainbow on Lake Rotoma. Catching that on Kevin's rod and lure will always be a special memory to me.

Once again, I was very lucky to grow up with fishing in my life, going down to the weigh station every Tuna Tournament and watching Dad and his friends come in with "big" fish (mind you that was when they were a lot younger and would leave the wharf to actually fish!)

When I got a bit older and it was my turn to start fishing in tournaments, my cousin Jayden and I would go out each year on my Uncle's boat Zambucca and stay out at White Island and fish the Annual Junior Tournament.

That is where I got to experience some awesome fishing from White Island trevally, night-time fishing- putting the light over the side and seeing the ocean light up and seeing all the layers of fish, catching flying fish with a net, putting them straight back down for Kingi's and then of course the sharks would turn up!

During the day we would troll for Tuna, and you were always guaranteed to catch something.

I will never take that for granted being able to grow up where there was such a huge amount of Yellowfin on our back doorstep.

One of my last years as a junior both Jayden and I hooked up a double of Yellow Fin one Junior Tournament, we landed both fish together and that got us both into the Yellowtail Kingfish tournament team for the Bay of Islands alongside Adam Goodhew and Ben Wilde.

Unfortunately for me I was the only girl and had to spend a week up north fishing with those boys!

We were lucky enough to get on double strike with Dave Arrell who was a hard but keen fisherman and taught us a lot. We also had Kevin McCracken and Dad as deckie.

That was a whole new experience of fishing for me fishing on light tackle, catching Kingi's on 6kg line was sure fun but totally different to what we are used too.

We were leading the whole Bay of Islands Tournament up until Bruce Smith and his team pipped us on the last hour. We still walked away with first overall junior team, the first for the club to ever do so which was special.

I will never forget my first ever Marlin. My sister and brother-in-law were up from Christchurch, and we decided to go out on the first Plan B for a Terakihi fish, as most of you know my old man has it in for Terakihi for some reason and we don't go home until that bin is full or our arms have fallen off from all those drifts at 120m.

After a successful morning catching Terakihi and one happy father, we decided to chuck the lures out on our way home, not even 20mins in the outriggers pop and we were on, it was my first time even seeing a Marlin jump let alone play it.

All I can remember was Dad screaming at everyone and telling my brother-in-law to be ready with the gaff (he doesn't normally yell but if you have been on a boat with him and a big fish takes the lure, be prepared to hear the real Goose Quack!) ... that poor guy was so nervous he held onto that gaff the whole time I was playing.

Dad reminded him not to stuff it up when it got to the boat which really didn't help! After a short but hard fight we landed it on the deck, gaff in the right place! And my brother-in-law still married to my sister!

It was an absolute surreal experience that I will never forget landing my first Marlin.

Fast forward to 2020 and 12 years after the last time Jayden and I had fished together...

We decided to give these Bluefin a crack down at Waihou Bay.

After all the crew pulled out at the last minute, we decided just the three of us would still go. First day with no luck we decided to get an early night.

After hearing one of the local boats had engine problems, Dad told us we would wait till light in the morning in case we needed to tow them home.

Once the sun came up and saw that the guy had got his boat going, we headed out.

It didn't take long before the rods started to scream, and we knew we were in; it was a double strike! The fish were pretty good and stayed away from each other which made the old man's job a lot easier!

We had the dog on board and normally she is very good at going to the toilet on the bow but for some reason this time she decided to take a poo right between us... Unbeknown to us Jayden and I had stood in it while playing our fish, Dad came downstairs and also stood in it... we couldn't help but laugh that there was dog shit from one end of the boat to the next as who really cared we were playing Bluefin!!!

Jayden got his in first and then I was able to focus on mine, 5 mins later it was on the deck, and we couldn't believe it. We couldn't believe that we had just caught not only one but two Bluefin!!

Last time we fished together we got a double of Yellowfin and 12 years later we landed a double of Bluefin. We were buzzing! You couldn't wipe that smile off our faces for a very long time. One of the best days on the water for me.

When Dad purchased Plan B formally known as Pursuit from Rick Pollock who would be one of the most successful charter fisherman NZ has ever had. There was a bit of pressure owning a boat that has been so successful all these years and especially out of Whakatane, but Dad had taken on the challenge and because of him, we have been so lucky to go further and catch more fish then we have been able to do so far.

I'm pretty lucky to have him as a Dad that's for sure!

We now fish the Nationals, representing Whakatane each year since owning Plan-B, which would have to be one of the best weeks of fishing I do each year.

We normally head up to Whitianga with a group of awesome guys, most of the time we meet Milton and the Silverado team up there which is always a bit of fun and lots of laughs.

Nationals is mostly based on tagging, which is awesome, we have been fortunate enough to catch a couple of Marlin, pop a tag in and watch them swim away which is always so cool to see and hopefully more people start to do it.

I'm sure you have all had enough reading about some of my fishing years.

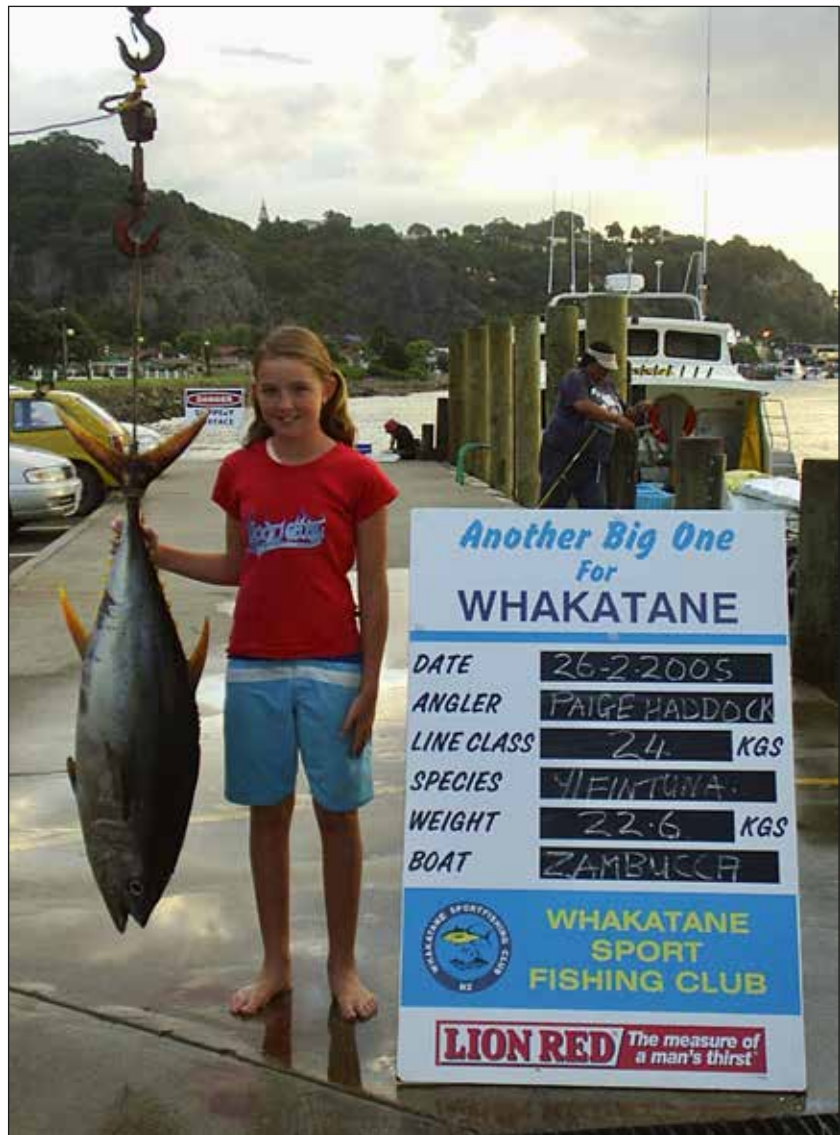
I could go on so much more, but I just want to say I will never take for granted how awesome our own backyard is and the memories I have of growing up as a junior and now a senior of this awesome club.

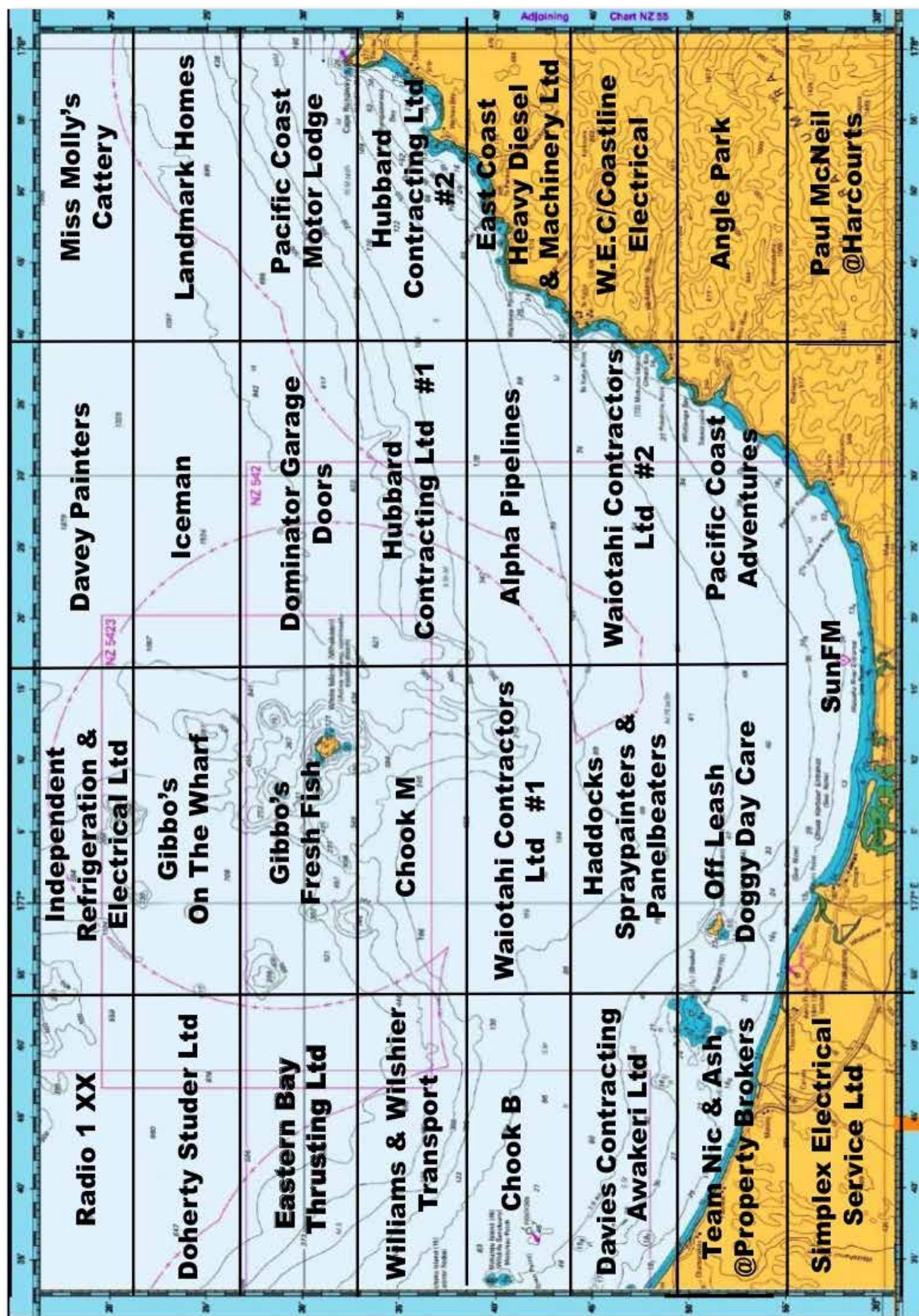
